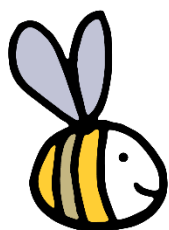

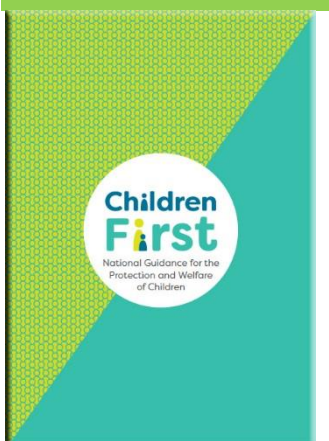

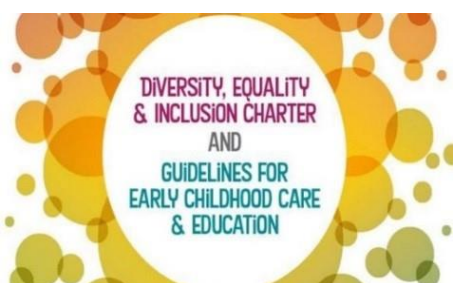
### Always Children First Foundation Training

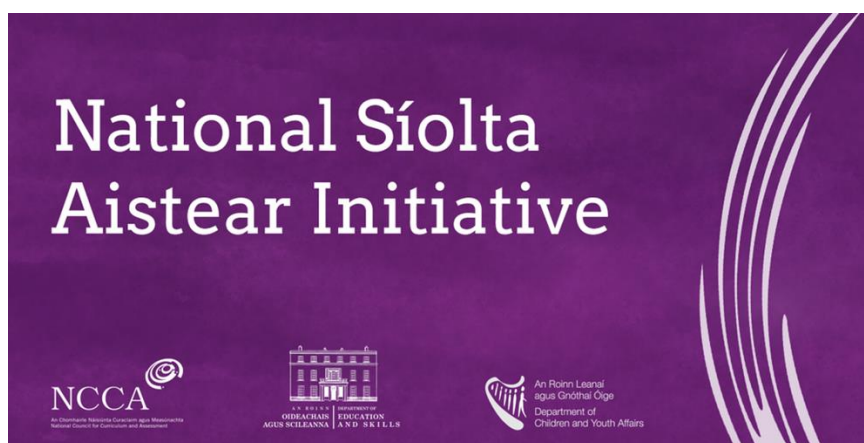
### Diversity, Equality and Inclusion Training
