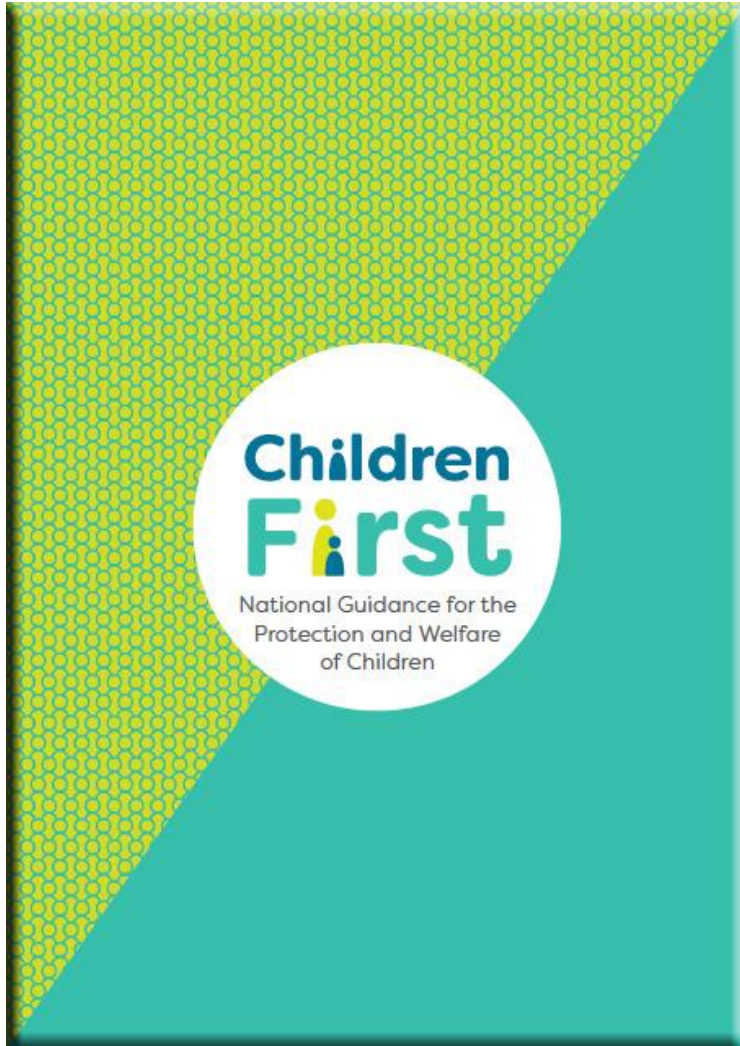
Síolta Awareness Raising Workshops
